About Monbulk

Monbulk is situated on the eastern slopes of the Dandenong Ranges surrounded by rolling hills, roughly between Belgrave and Mount Evelyn, and adjacent to Silvan, and is part of the Shire of Yarra Ranges. Whereas in past years Monbulk was famous for its jams, it is now surrounded by a variety of prosperous horticultural farms with Monbulk as a servicing hub for these industries, which includes The Patch, and Silvan areas.

Monbulk has a thriving business centre built around the needs of its community, with two supermarkets (Woolworths and Aldi), Bendigo Bank, medical and counselling centres, financial planners, real estate agents, servicing facilities for motor vehicles, farm machinery and equipment, bicycles, and a raft of cafés, bakeries, and restaurants.

According to the 2021 Census, Monbulk and its surrounds house just over 6,100 people. Educationally, Monbulk is well serviced with 2 Primary Schools, covering State and Catholic education, and Monbulk Secondary College, with several other primary schools in surrounding townships. There is good collaboration between the various churches in Monbulk and the other community-based organisations. Most people in Monbulk are from Australian, British, or European backgrounds.
